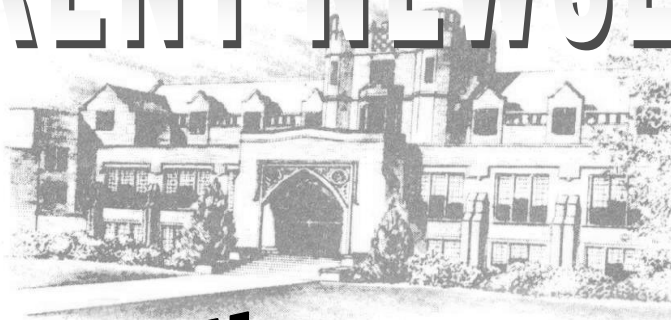

## FROM THE PRINCIPAL

Each year, new initiatives are introduced at Dixon High School in order to improve student achievement. Periodically, the staff examines these procedures to assess their effectiveness. This year, test retakes were implemented at Dixon High School to assist student learning. Our current practice allows students to retake tests one time. The idea behind this concept is to allow students additional time to learn concepts that they may not have initially understood. The staff and administration have had several lengthy discussions on this topic and are considering modifying this practice for second semester. When this decision is made, parents and students will be notified.

Another new initiative at Dixon High School was our athletic/activity study tables. The purpose of these study tables was to provide our students who are involved in extra-curricular activities with academic support immediately after school. Several concerns from students involved in fall activities were brought to my attention and addressed. I applaud our sponsors and coaches for their creativity in resolving these issues. ## REGISTRATION FOR 2012-13

Registration for the 2012-2013 school years will begin in mid-February. Counselors will give students course listings needed for graduation and a copy of their most recent transcript. Juniors will meet for registration information in the auditorium on 01/27/12, sophomores on 2/03/12, and Freshman on 2/10/12. RMS 8<sup>th</sup> grade students will register in the DHS cafeteria February 15th and 16th. Students will be asked to bring this material home to review their course selections for the following year with their parents. Course descriptions and the course selection worksheet will be accessible on-line at the DHS Counseling website. A verification of student course selections will be sent home for parent approval.
