Last week, I visited several classrooms and spoke to students about the importance of personalizing their education. Specifically, I want every student to connect what they do in the classroom to their future career plan and if they do not see the relevance in what they are doing to ask their teachers to help them make this connection. If students can do this on a regular basis, they will be successful both at Dixon High School and in the future. The acronym PLC stands for “Professional Learning Community” and is a practice where teachers look at student achievement data and work together to decide how best to educate each child. After reviewing our PSAE data, one of our goals is to improve our students’ writing skills. I encourage all parents to talk to their children to ask what they have been asked to write about in their classes. With your help and the efforts of the students and teachers, we will improve a vital skill, writing, for all of our students.

I would like to take this time to congratulate our fall athletic teams for their successes that they achieved in our first year of the NIB 12 conference. As of October 24, 2010, Dixon High School student-athletes were conference champions in girls’ tennis, girls’ cross country, and boys’ golf while the boys’ soccer and boys’ cross country teams earned second place finishes. In the state tournament series, the boys’ golf, boys’ cross country, and girls’ cross country teams were regional champs with the latter two still competing. On an individual level, Amanda Kent and Jennifer Guenther earned a berth at state in girls tennis doubles while Mitchell Homb was this year’s class 2A state golf champion! I would like to congratulate all of these athletes and their parents for a job well done and thank you all for representing Dixon High School in such a positive manner. I look forward to continued success in the winter.

## REGISTRATION FOR 2011-12

Registration for the 2011-2012 school years will begin in mid-February. Counselors will give students course listings needed for graduation and a copy of their most recent transcript. Juniors on 2/11/11, sophomores on 2/18/11, and Freshman on 2/25/11. RMS 8<sup>th</sup> grade students will register in the DHS cafeteria March 2 and 3<sup>rd</sup>. Students will be asked to bring this material home to review their course selections for the following year with their parents. Course descriptions and the course selection worksheet will be accessible on-line at the DHS Counseling website. A verification of student course selections will be sent home for parent approval.

## THE ACT TEST

ALL JUNIORS will be taking a combination ACT/Prairie State Test (PSAE) on April 27th & 28th. Since almost all Midwest colleges require the ACT for admission, this is an opportunity to take it for free.

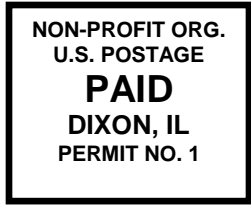
